## 2018 YEAR 7 ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Woodmans Hill is offering academic scholarships to students entering the campus at Year 7 in 2018.

### Criteria:

The scholarships are for students who:

- a) Are achieving a high standard of school work, especially in the areas of literacy and numeracy
- b) Have shown an admirable attitude and leadership qualities.

### Value of Scholarships:
